The Motorola Gary Daniels Scholarship for Leaders

A scholarship for an undergraduate student, with preference given to a student in a leadership position of an Electrical and Computer Engineering Department ("ECE") University recognized student organization

Established in 2022

The scholarship has supported two students so far

- 1 current ECE student in their fourth year (\$800)
- 1 ECE student who is now an alum (\$500)

The Motorola Gary Daniels Scholarship for Leaders

The Motorola Gary Daniels Scholarship is not fully funded yet. The gift goal is \$50,000, and the current book value is \$39,100. **\$10,900 to go!**

Once the scholarship is fully funded, more students will be able to benefit from your generosity.

IRA Giving – QCD's

Making IRA transfers to UT Austin is a win-win

If you are 70 (1/2) or older, you may direct your required minimum distribution from your IRA to a charity like the University of Texas at Austin without treating the distribution as taxable income. This is referred to as a qualified charitable distribution – QCD.

Neutralizes the negative tax consequences of an RMD

Your IRA gift could help a talented student achieve their dream of being the first in their family to graduate from college.

IRA Giving – Beneficiaries

No matter your age, you can designate UT as the beneficiary of all or a percentage of your IRA.

Since inherited retirement accounts are often burdened with a sizable income-tax liability (up to 37% for non-spouse heirs), many Longhorns use their retirement accounts for charitable bequests to forever link their story to UT's future.
