Speaker: R. Douglas Pauley, MBA, CFP, CSA, BCI, of Pauley Financial Services

Topic: Tying Up Life's Loose Ends

As a result of his father's death in 1999, Doug created this presentation to motivate others to tie up their own life's "loose ends." The Letters of Instruction provide the family a host of information needed immediately upon one's passing. The Letter of Love grew out of a letter that Doug's father wrote to his children prior to his death. The other letters in the presentation provide personal instructions to the fiduciaries entrusted with executing one's estate plan.

Editor's note: This subject is a little "heavier" than our usual fare. However, I think you may find it very useful. My brother passed away unexpectedly in November of last year and HAD NO WILL. He was single, had no children, and owned no real estate, but dealing with even his very limited estate has been a right, royal pain - even after we got through with the immediate issues of notification of friends and what to do about a funeral or memorial. I've learned lots of things I never wanted to know.

DO NOT leave this to your family and MAKE SURE (as well as anyone can, of course) that you don't get left without any guidance to do it for others in your family.

In an effort to help curb identity theft, we've all been issued new Health Plan account numbers (it's not the SSN anymore). The new account number is shown on the new ID card sent out in December.

Also, you now have a health account PIN. See the letter sent out by Mototola in December. You will need this PIN to access you information via the rewards administration website (https://RAC.motorola.com) or the customer service phone line (800-421-3974).

If you have not registered on the retiree benefits website and/or updated your PIN, we STRONGLY urge you to do so. As the PIN and other information was sent out in separate documents last year and all services were not in place at that time, you might have missed it. The April 2003 Retirees Rewards pamphlet you recently received seems to summarize where things stand now. Please review this, visit the various web sites and make sure you have and know your password(s) and PIN now so you don't have a problem the next time you really need to use them.
