## Minutes of February 13, 2007, General Membership Meeting

General Membership Meeting of MFLSRC held at Austin Senior Citizen Center at 10am on May 8, 2007. Minutes as follows:

Minutes from Prior meetings approved as is.

Treasury Report: Roger summarized treasury activities report. Accounted for meeting door prizes and lunch expense, picnic costs, and office costs. Reported paying \$98 in Federal Income Tax for 2006.

Benefits Update. Freescale had nothing new to report regarding any changes in retiree coverage. Typically, budgets are discussed in the October timeframe. Submitted questions were addressed by Freescale. PHX Freescale contacts indicate there will be no formal discussions on budget until November timeframe.

Scholarship Committee: Patricia Gossman, Jim Wilson, Jo Anne Reviewed 22 applications for the scholarship awards. Criteria included aptitude, class rank, extra curricular activities, GPA, community service, need for assistance, and motivation. The recipients were Kimberly, Olga, and Elizabeth.

Membership Recognition: Patricia Gossman proposed a program that recognizes individuals for outstanding contributions to the club. Such a program should stimulate involvement, encourage membership, and recognize achievement of members. Also floated an idea for sponsorship through local businesses. Speaker: Holly Roepke - Senior Program Specialists for Senior Activity Center. Originally established in 1978, it is the oldest center in Austin. The Blue Ribbon Policy Book established in 1990 has been the guiding reference standard for many other community senior centers around the country. The Center currently has 155 active volunteers that are critical for the success of the programs offered. The fifteen member board makes overall strategy for the programs, but the volunteers make them a success.

A library is available which contains books, puzzles, etc., all available on the honor system. In addition, there is an Adult Adventure Center on Lady Bird Lake that features a weight machine, jewelry making, biking, fishing, and computers. There are bridge classes, computer labs, dancing, painting, yoga, and trips available to members. At certain times, tax consultants are available at no charge to assist in preparing Federal Income Tax Returns. There are five trips/month that focus on places of interest within approx. a 100 mile radius. Trips are centered around a variety of interesting places, restaurants, cultural events, and fun activities. Typical trip fees range from \$8-40 and Senior Activity Center annual donation is \$3.
