Minutes of May 11, 2010, General Membership Meeting

Wayne Harned (acting for Jim Remedi) opened the meeting at 10:15am with a welcome. The minutes of the previous meeting in February were read and approved. Motion was made to approve the minutes by Al Alaspa. There were several seconds.

Wayne mentioned that openings still exist for the slate of elected officers next year. He also reminded the attendees that people can only run twice based on the current by-laws.

Mike Coley gave the treasurer's report. Since the last meeting, funds are up \$30.78. Deposits from members for the picnic were \$560. Total account balance is currently \$22,917.89.

Loy Buley reported that there are currently 160 paid members with 61 being lifetime. There are 8 new members having just paid. Also there are 30 people that have not yet paid current dues from last year.

Thanks were given to Al Alaspa for all the work done to make the recent picnic a success.

Mike Coley discussed the issues with the current MFLSRC website. He said that the current software has real problems that cannot be fixed. He asked the members present if they would support expenses to get the website fixed. In addition, Pat Haner has agreed to maintain the site for free. Motion was made by Gary Daniels and seconded by Wayne Harned to do this.

Only one of the two speakers was present at the meeting as arranged by Gary Daniels. Zoi Kondis was introduced as the spokesman for the Capital Area Food Bank. She reported that the food bank (established in 1981) works with 350 agencies throughout central Texas to collect food and that their group supplied over 22M# of food in 2009. The Executive Board Meeting, July 13, 2010

Present for the meeting – Al Alaspa, Jim Remedi, Danna Redford, Loy Buley, Gary Daniels, Brent Brown, and Jim Binneboese Minutes of the April meeting were approved.

Loy Buley read the membership report. Total paid up members – 160. There are 61 lifetime memberships and 7 new memberships so far this year. There are 151 past members that have not renewed. The dues are payable every year in January. The club is still actively looking for new members.

Gary Daniels reported that there would be two speakers for the August 10th general membership meeting. One is Phil Kuhlenbeck, who will speak on Clear WiMAX technology. This technology uses Motorola modem products. Gary will ask Phil if he can speak in August since he missed the May meeting. Also speaking is a representative from American Red Cross chapter in Austin.

Al Alaspa reported that the total cost for the 2010 picnic was \$923.00. Attendance was 55 people. The format of the picnic seemed to be well received.

Suggestion made by Gary Daniels to have Bingo at our general membership meetings along with prizes. This will be announced in the August meeting. If approved, we will start in the fall.

Jim Remedi reported that Betty Temple has volunteered to set up the Christmas lunch. The date is Dec. 7th. Details are in the current newsletter. Discussion was held about the main door prize which has traditionally been a gift certificate for a B&B in Fredericksburg. We thought that this year we'd offer a wider choice to the winner: the B&B, a comparable restaurant meal, or gift card (so, for example, the winner could choose the gift card and use it to buy gas for the next vacation).

A post card will be handed out at the next membership meeting in August listing all the elected positions available along with a list of the charities we have nominated. Members attending will be asked to vote for their favorite charity for a MFLSRC annual donation (budgeted) and also to mark any elected position(s) they may be interested in filling. The Exec. Committee will bring the charity recommendation to the next membership meeting in November and also announce the candidates for office.

Tidbits That Are Good to Know

November 2008

In the year the Motorola/Freescale retiree turns 65, there are changes in the medical/dental/vision insurance. My understanding is that the retiree and their spouse's existing policies are basically cancelled. The retiree signs up for the Humana PFFS plan and the under 65 spouse is automatically put on new Aetna medical, Humana dental, and Vision plans. The spouse's new plan resets to zero dental and vision coverage used for the year. This means that if you used some or all of the dental and vision coverage before the retiree turns 65 you will receive another full set of coverage for the rest of the year. You should check this with Humana and the Vision plan before you try to use this. I'm not sure if the same thing happens when the spouse turns 65 and the retiree is less than 65 years old.

August 2008

- 1) Set-up meeting at Social Security office you can wait for hours to be seen if you just go into the social security office and get a number. It's possible to call ahead of time and get an appointment for a specific time on a specific day. Early in the day and after lunch are good times for the meeting.
 - a. Sign-up for Medicare (this happens at the Social Security office)
 - i. Call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213 to set-up appointment
 - b. Sign-up for Social Security and for problems
 - i. Call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213 to set-up appointment
- 2) Age 65 and over retirees, Humana PFFS "Evidence of Coverage" booklet
 - a. In the initial information that Humana sends when you sign-up for this plan, they say that after you enroll you will receive the "Evidence of Coverage" booklet. I never did receive this booklet and I would bet that I am not the only one who did not receive it.
 - b. Call Humana at the number on the back of your membership card and request the booklet. I have done this and it has much more information than what you got with the sign-up forms.

May 2009

When I looked at my 2009 Notice of Appraised Value from Travis County, the school taxes had not frozen at the 2008 tax amount, as they should have. The exemptions were shown correctly for both 2008 and 2009. I went to see someone at the Travis Central Appraisal District Office at 8314 Cross Park Dr. and after checking into this they said the projected tax information I got was wrong. The person I talked with said this was caused by a software glitch and it has also happened to other taxpayers. She changed the school tax to the correct amount and gave me a printout of what she had done.
