Minutes of the General Meeting, February 10, 2015

Al Scholin called the meeting to order at 10:05 am. The agenda was presented. The prior meeting minutes were discussed and offered for approval. A motion was made to approve the minutes by Gary Daniels and seconded by Jim Binneboese and the minutes were approved.

Obie Hasty gave the Treasurer's report.

The MFLSRC bank account cash has decreased by \$1,067.30 since our last meeting in November and a total of \$3,108.61 for the year. Income for the period was \$1,370.81, and expenses were \$2,438.11. Actual performance vs. the 2014 budget was reviewed. We missed our budgeted deficit of \$1338.00 by \$1,740.61 and had a total income vs. expense deficit of \$3,078.61.

Major impact items included having to use the Norris Center for the 2nd half of the year and a miss in the income budgeted for the Christmas party. A chart showing income versus expenses was shown for all of our major events.

A proposed budget for 2015 was presented and approved. The 2015 budget has a deficit of \$1,164.00, and closely matches the 2014 budget that was missed. The Board will try to close the deficit gap as we go through the year.

Loy Buley presented the membership status and indicated that with the recent payment of dues membership is up slightly versus last year. Loy also indicated that there have recently been a couple of people who have generously donated additional funds to help the club's financial position. Thanks was given to these unnamed individuals.

Gary Daniels introduced our speaker, Chris Hartman, from Freescale. Chris works in the Finance Department and is focused on investor relations.

He showed us his investors presentation and indicated that he felt Freescale was well positioned for the future and was either #1 or #2 in their chosen product markets. Chris cited the recent stock price increases that indicate that they are doing well with the investment community. Chris reported that Freescale had \$4.6B in sales for 2014 and grew 6.1% in 2013 versus 2012 and grew 10.7% 2014 versus 2013. For 2014 gross margin was 45.9% and operating revenue was \$848M.

Freescale is the corporate sponsor of the Austin Marathon which will be run on Sunday, the 15th of February. They are also taking a different approach to marketing and customer awareness by acquiring a large semi tractor/trailer rig which travels around the country showcasing Freescale and its products. The semi will be in Austin for the marathon.

Gary Daniels thanked our speaker for his information and announced that he had secured a speaker for our next meeting on Tuesday, May 12. Dr. Johnson, Dean of the new U.T. Medical school, will be our speaker and will give us an update on the plans and schedules for the new medical school here in Austin.

Wayne Harned reported on plans for our picnic which will be held at the Mike and Betty Temple compound on Tuesday, April 21. Cost to attend the picnic has been lowered to \$10 per person and people need to get their money to Loy Buley to attend. Car pooling is being encouraged and those willing to drive and those needing a ride should also contact Loy to get on the car pool list for matching. Maps to the Temple compound, near Smithville, were handed out.

Remembrances for our colleagues who have passed was presented by Al Scholin. Roger Mao, Robert (Bob) Swiatek and Jane Zuck were listed.

The meeting was adjourned, bingo was played and pizza was enjoyed by all for lunch.
