Personal Myths and Discovering Your Inner Greatness. He managed a casino night for the annual Multiple

Sclerosis Society Tiki Night fundraiser and founded the Pectus Excavatum Foundation for chest wall deformities.

GENERAL MEETING, May 10, 2022

Attendees: The first in-person meeting of 2021-22 was called to order at the Senior Center at 10:05 A.M., by Sandra Lawell with >25 members and guests in attendance.

<u>Welcome:</u> President Sandra Lawell welcomed everyone and introduced Janet Tidwell as the new Membership Chairperson. The guest speaker, Mike Collins, was introduced by long-time friend Tom Starnes.

<u>Guest Speaker:</u> Mike Collins, "Just a Boy from Oklahoma", spoke about his early years growing up in Tulsa and his interest in electronics and computers. His career began in the Petrochemical industry.

He joined Motorola semiconductor in 1978 as a Field Applications Engineer in Houston, moved to Austin in 1982, and became the Digital Signal Processing Marketing Manager in 1988. He discussed his career, and the Motorola Semiconductor Product line history. He also recounted many humorous incidents which occurred throughout his career; additionally, he included many of his activities after leaving Motorola. His presentation will be available on the MAAC website.

<u>New Business</u>: Sandra asked for recommendations for meeting speakers/topics. Jim B. has asked Brad Wheelis, Public Information Officer @ TXDoT, to speak at the August meeting about road plans/traffic in Austin.

Bill Pfaff made a motion that we notify UT to assign all Gary Daniels/Motorola contributions to the Motorola Gary Daniels Leadership Fund; this endowment will be managed by University of Texas (UT) and UT will award scholarships after \$50,000 is collected. This motion was seconded and approved.

Seven people have committed to contribute \$1K per year for 5 years. If 3 or more people agree to do the same, we will be able to commence scholarship distribution in 5 years.
