Speaker: Mitchel Wong, M.D. was born in Austin. His parents started their grocery business in 1937, and he grew up in South Austin and attended William B Travis High school. Following this he attended the University of Texas from 1957 - 1960 graduating in 1960. He received his M.D. from Baylor Medical School graduating in 1964. He completed his ophthalmology residency and fellowship prior to starting Austin Eye in 1969. He and his wife Rose have 4 sons. All of his children chose to stay in Austin. 2 of them are ophthalmologists, one is an attorney and one an architectural photographer.

Topic: Dr. Wong will speak of his childhood and the chain of events that led him from the grocery business to specializing in Ophthalmology to establishing the Department of Ophthalmology at Dell Medical school to land development in Austin. And most recently Mitchel and Rose Wong, along with their sons and their families, came together to create a more than \$20 million eye institute at Dell Medical School.
